After managing a North American Notary Node throughout 2017, we have grown our knowledge of the Komodo platform and demonstrated our competence by being in the top ten of notarizations.

Based on our experience, the Galt Mines team is now looking to accept responsibility for the availability and maintenance of three new Notary Nodes. One in the Southern Hemisphere, one in Europe and one in Asia.

This is a commitment that the three of us are happy to take on, expanding and utilizing our experience and talents to strengthen the platform.

We recognize the growing importance of the role that Notaries play, as other projects utilize the Komodo Platform. To further encourage the stability and longevity of the notary system we will be forming a business group to discuss and develop legal and financial protection strategies.

We are working to structure a legal entity to handle the unique nature of this decentralized 21st-century business and are eager to share ideas and collaborate.

Further details and invitations will be shared in the coming weeks.

We will also hold 15% of our revenue from each new Notary Node and use it to fund services and projects that serve the Komodo mission, this is what we call 'Shenlong's Den'.

5% of funds from our notaries will be used to unleash "the Juan" to various conferences to network and help promote the Komodo ecosystem.

We will continually reinvest in server hardware and facilities to increase reliability and capacity. We see having dedicated self-owned sites as an essential step in building a flexible platform.

Ryan will be offering an open source solution for monitoring Notary Nodes using Nagios, a software product that he is highly proficient. This should help the community maintain their Notaries availability and reduce troubleshooting time.

Some of the KMD from the South American notary will go towards funding the construction of our 2nd physical Galt Mines location in Southern Chile. Travis will focus on this aspect, building out the physical foundation of the crypto-economy while documenting his work and providing a site design guide to the notary community. Developing a best-practices guide will strengthen the ecosystem as a whole.
